

Drama Elite Pathway Auditions 2026

We would like to invite applicants into school in order to audition for their place on the Drama Elite Pathway. Please see details below for when the auditions will take place and what is expected:

When does testing take place?

In school testing will take place at St. Peter's High School on **Wednesday 7th October 4-5pm**. Students will be met in the main reception by a member of the drama department and taken down to the theatre for their workshop and audition.

What does the workshop entail?

During the workshop, applicants will be asked to complete a number of tasks that assess: their team skills, creativity, improvisation and response to direction.

What do I need to prepare?

All students MUST prepare a 60-120 second monologue for performance. They are expected to be off script and the monologue must be from a published play. Students who do not prepare and perform a monologue will receive a mark of 0 for this element.

Who will assess me?

Applicants will be assessed by the head of drama, Mrs Skyrme and another Drama teacher.

Who should apply?

Anyone who has a passion for Drama and performing.

Please note that Catholic students need not apply. There will be opportunities for Catholic students to join the Elite Pathway once they start at the school. The aptitude testing is designed to give students who show an aptitude in Drama, Sports or Music, a higher ranking on the admissions table who are not Catholic. The ranking for students who pass the aptitude testing is below students who are Catholic.

When is the deadline for applications?

The deadline for applications for Aptitude testing is 6th September 2026. Any applications received after this date will not be considered.
