



ST PETER'S MUSIC APTITUDE TESTING FOR SEPTEMBER 2027 ENTRY



Your child is invited to attend the **MUSIC** aptitude test to be held at St Peter's High School on **Tuesday 22nd September**. The testing will commence at 4.15pm and should finish by 5.45pm. Please report to the Main Reception at 4pm, where a member of the Music Department will meet you.

- Applicants should bring a prepared piece of music (between 1 & 2 minutes in length) to perform on the day. This can be:
 - in any style
 - on any instrument or voice
 - with or without piano accompaniment
 - with or without a backing track
 - with or without sheet music
- Applicants will take part in a range of tests to assess their musical aptitude, including observations of rhythm and pitch, musical memory, listening & emotional response.
- Applicants will acquire a score for each test. Up to four students who accumulate the highest scores (and meet the minimum requirement) will qualify for Category 7 of the school's 2027 Admissions Policy. It is worth noting that if your child is Catholic, they will be automatically ranked higher than a child who is awarded an Aptitude placement.
- The deadline for applications is **Sunday 6th September 2026**. You will be notified of the result on or before 20th October 2026.
- Applicants will need to wear appropriate & comfortable clothes. It is recommended that they bring a water bottle & snack with them.
